//CIRCULAR//

Sub: Guidelines to review class VIII annual result 2010.

Right to Education Act which will come into force w.e.f. 1.4.2010 mandates that 'No Detention Policy' shall be observed for the children of Class VIII. Therefore, it will be obviously applicable for the academic year 2010-11 onwards. The Directorate of Education already has a policy of No Detention upto class VII. During the current academic year, the result of class VIII reveals that in some cases, students have failed on account of poor performance in annual exam in one or two subjects. Therefore, it has been decided to issue the following guidelines for moderation:

1. The HOS is authorised to grant upto a maximum of 5 marks in comprehensive exams (i.e. Annual Exams) only in those cases where students are short of maximum of 2 marks for securing 25% marks in a particular subject, subject to the following conditions:

- a. Not more than 2 marks are awarded in one subject.
- b. Total 5 marks can be spread over in the following manner:
 - i. 2 marks each in two subjects and 1 mark in one subject (Total 5).
 - ii. 1 mark each in maximum 5 subjects (Total 5).
 - iii. 2 marks in one subject and 1 mark each in three subjects (Total 5).

2. Moderation is to be done by HOS personally under his /her signature on Broad sheets in respect of those candidates only who after moderation are eligible for Promotion to next higher class as per Promotion Rules 2001-02. For any deviation from the above norms mentioned in (a) and (b) above, HOS would be held responsible.

3. No student of class VIII should be detained in the class on account of failure in Science Practical, provided he/she passes in Science theory. In such cases, a chance to reappear in Science Practical is to be given at school level within a week.


4. The broadsheet of class VIII after Moderation is to be kept in the custody of HOS for inspection of higher authorities.

5. The Moderation in the result of Comprehensive exams as per above conditions is applicable only for the current academic session 2009-2010.

6. However, all students who are not able to pass even after moderation will get another chance through compartment examination. The compartment will be given to them in all the failing subjects without considering their marks in the subject.

7. The moderation for class VIII will be done by the HOS immediately and the entry of moderated marks by the HOS must be completed latest by 6 April 2010 (Tuesday).
