**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**OPPORTUNITY FOR SETTLEMENT OF PENDING ELECTRIC/ WATER DUES  
& PAYMENT OF ELECTRIC / WATER CHARGES**

The New Delhi Municipal Council has introduced a scheme for the settlement of pending dues of electric / water charges and their payment. This scheme will be applicable for all the categories of electric/ water consumers in NDMC area such as Government Offices (Bulk & HT Bulk), Non-Gazetted (NG & NGM), Gazetted Officers (GOB), Private Shops and Establishments (Private & HT Pvt.), Members of Parliament and Ministers having arrears due to any type of dispute in consumption charges viz. Provisional Demand, Misuse charges, Replacement of energy meters, etc. Under this scheme, all the dues are proposed to be settled amicably within the following terms and conditions :

**Principal Demand**

1. The principal demand of the consumption charges shall not ordinarily reduced.

**Misuse Charges**

2. The misuse charges can be reduced at the present level @ 50% of the applicable tariff. If special reasons are given and a case made out by consumer, the misuse charges can be reduced to less than 50% for special reasons to be recorded in writing.

**Demand against Government Departments**

3. The cases where arrears are outstanding against the Government offices, buildings and departments, on payment of principal amount, surcharge shall be considered for waiver.

**Old Cases**

4. Cases of arrears of the period prior to September 1996, will be settled on the basis of information provided by consumer & available in NDMC.
5. The cases still pending in any court are proposed to be settled under :-  
  
"The case shall be taken up for amicable settlement. On quantification of the demand, consumer shall pay the said demand with 8% simple interest from the dates, the said demand is due. The case shall get settled on payment of the said demand and interest by 30.04.2008 and withdrawal of court case".
6. In cases where arrears are undisputed and not paid due to levy of surcharge, the case shall be settled on consumer paying the arrears of consumption charges and simple interest at 8% from the date it is due by 30.04.2008.

7. If a case is not covered under the above proposed clauses of settlement, the Chairman, NDMC will have it settled through a Committee for Settlement of Disputes.
8. The revised demand settled under this scheme will have to be deposited in the Municipal treasury either in one lump sum or within a reasonable time before 30.04.2008 through demand Draft/ Pay Order in favour of Secretary, NDMC.

The consumers who are willing to settle their cases under this scheme will have to apply to the Director (Commercial) in writing along with entire details consumer nos., premises where the connection exists and nature of outstanding dues, interim/ stay orders. The applications received after this stipulated date will not be entertained under this scheme.
