1 3.1 The RCC (Reinforced Cement Concrete) roads work in Bharti Nagar Colony will be completed within this financial year.

3 3.2 Resurfacing of roads through bituminous mastic treatment is in progress at B.K. Dutt Colony, Aliganj and Jor Bagh.

Only 35% work is completed. The contractor has stopped the work inspite of number of reminders and Show Cause Notices. The work is being rescinded and will be completed in next financial year. However, some patch repairs in the colony have been carried out.

4 3.3 Resurfacing of road through microsurfacing treatment as recommended by CRRI is in progress at 34 roads. Another 6 roads with micro surfacing will be completed in the next financial year. In addition, to minimize the time and costs towards repairs especially of potholes and small cuts in roads, we are experimenting with the model of hot mix patches and micro surfacing as the technology of choice.

Potholes patch repair is in progress and shall be completed upto March-2015, Moreover, it is a continuos process.Out of 34 roads the work of resurfacing through Hot Mix Technology has been completed on two roads. The work of micro-surfacing has been completed on 24 roads and about 75% work has been completed.5 roads have been deferred due to revised recommendation by CRRI and will be taken up seperately. Further, work is in progress. The NIT for another 6 roads is under scrutinity in Planning Department.Approval-in-principle for additional/extra quantity to complete the work has been accorded by the council.

Construction of four new 33KV Sub-Stations at Church Road, Janpath, Aliganj & Delhi High Court were planned in the previous two years. Substation buildings for 33KV Sub-station at Aliganj and at Delhi High Court are being constructed by CPWD/Delhi PWD. The establishment of 33KV Substation at these two sites will be completed in the next financial year after handover of built-up area by these agencies. As construction of 33KV Sub-station at Janpath, an alternative site at the parking behind Tolstoy Marg has been

37 10.1 We are planning to upgrade the Solid Waste Management (Environmental Sanitation) in the entire NDMC area through Integrated Waste Management System an -'end-to-end' solution to waste management, by collecting waste from doorsteps and transporting the garbage for disposal Timarpur-Okhla Waste management Co. Ltd. (TOWMCL) Plant, Okhla in a scientific and mechanized manner, eliminating the need for 'dhalao" points, which become the cause of unhygienic condition and citizen Toilets. We have finalized the RFP in which the municipal solid waste transporting it by mechanical dissatisfaction.

Solid waste management in NDMC area has been upgraded through integrated management system wherein end to end solution to waste management by collecting garbage from doorsteps and transporting the garbage for disposal to Waste to Energy Plant, Okhla in scientific manner has been implemented. The infrastructure for solid waste management system has been strengthened by deploying 26 auto tipper having tipping system for door to door collection from residential and market areas of NDMC. Door to door collection has been implemented in the entire NDMC area to the satisfaction of the RWAs and MTAs. Each circle has been provided with one mechanical compactor for collection and transportation of garbage from NDMC area to Waste to Energy Plant, Okhla. The removal of the garbage during the night shift has also been strengthened. NDMC has deployed 1275 new iron bin trolleys of 1100 ltr. capacity at various garbage collection points in NDMC area.

Eventually, these dhalaos will be converted to Public compactors to TOWMCL Plant, Okhla.

In addition to this 20 high capacity iron trolley having 4.5 cubic meter high capacity have been placed at hot point area of NDMC to cater to high volume of garbage. These high capacity bins are compatible with auto tipper and mechanical compactors and improve the efficiency of collection of garbage in area. 144 new tricycle rickshaw have been procured and being used in NDMC area to meet with the requirement of collection and transporting small heaps of garbage from the road, lane, by-lanes etc. The new system of collection and transportation of garbage in NDMC area is 100% mechanized by deployment of mechanical compactors and has eliminated the need for dustbin/ dhalao points which become the cause of unhygienic condition and citizen dissatisfaction. The list having about 50 nos. of the garbage stations /masonry dustbins to be converted into toilet block/public conveniences has been sent to the Civil Engineering Department for starting the work of construction of toilet block/ public conveniences.

As part of this process, plan to construct state-of-the-art Transfer Stations in NDMC area for increasing efficiency in collection of waste, towards quick removal of garbage as well as timely availability of garbage transport vehicles. Removal of garbage from Transfer Stations to terminal disposal site will be easy during nights, there being lesser traffic on the roads at that time. The process will be eventually on "Just-in-time" principle, to prevent garbage spillage at the junctions.
