## Conditions of Supply

### **Security Deposit**

According to the Scale approved by the Council from time to time

**NOTE :-** The deposit money referred to above is a minimum for light, fans and motor Power installations only and the council reserves the right to demand large sum if considered necessary.

**A.C. Pressure**

The Supply Pressure will be 230 volts, Single Phase for load upto 10.00 K.W. and 400 volts, 3 phase for load above 10.00 K.W.

**Notice for  
Disconnection**

The consumer shall be deemed to be taking a supply and shall be responsible for payments etc. until he has handed over to the Council one month's notice in writing to discontinue the supply and such notice shall have expired a facilities have been given by the Consumer to disconnect the supply.

**Payment of  
Accounts**

Payment to be made monthly within 15 days of presentation of accounts.

**Disconnection**

The municipal council is entitled under the D.E.R.C. and I.E. Act, to disconnect any connection for non-payment of account. On expiration of notice given for disconnection for the non-payment, orders are issued to the Electrical Engineer, New Delhi Municipal Council for disconnection. Some time consumer call to make payment after such orders have been issued but before intimation has been executed or not. In all such cases a consumer must deposit.

**Conn. fee**

Per meter and if it is subsequently founds that disconnection has not been made this amount will be adjusted by credit to the consumer in the next bill. The council is also entitled to disconnect in the extent, of a consumer's installation being in unsatisfactory condition or if any alterations or addition are made to the installation without obtaining sanction of the council.



Interference with  
meter and  
Terminals

Every consumer is responsible for seeing that no person who is not duly authorised by the council for purpose shall in any way interfere with the Meter Seals and Fuses. The penalty for improper interference is fined as per rule.

Electrical  
installation

All wiring for light and fans etc. including extension to installations must be tested by the Council representative before being connected to the supply. The test made by the council will show up any serious defect which exists on the wiring at the time of test but it is not guaranteed that such fault may not occur at the latter date due to bad workmanship materials. No supply will be given unless the wiring work is interested to firms on the approved list of the Electrical Inspector to the Government.

One test will be made free of charge by the council but if the installation is not passed at this test, it will not be connected until it has been passed and a free for reinspection must be paid for each subsequent test.

Service connection  
Deposit

The deposit must be whenever any connection is opened either for new or an old consumer. If connection is an old which was put up for a previous tenant the amount deposited by him is refundable subject to dues to council being properly settled.

NOTE :-

The maximum No. of points allowed on a single service connection must not exceed 40 or a load of 10 amps. The maximum number of point per circuit must not exceed 10.

#### **RULE 45 OF INDIAN ELECTRICITY RULES, 1956**

**Precaution to be adopted by Consumers, Owners, Electrical Contractors,  
Electrical Workman and Suppliers.**

No Electrical installation work, including additions. Alterations, repairs and adjustment to existing installations except such replacement of Lamps, Fans, Switches, low Voltage domestic appliance and fitting as in no way alters its capacity or character shall be carried out upon the premises of or on behalf any consumer or owner except by a Electrical Contractor licensed in this behalf by the State Government and under the direct supervision of person holding a certificate or competency issued or recongnised by the State Government.
