Replies of the observations to Personnel Department are as follows:-

1. Radiologists are qualified to read the x-rays, MRI & CT Scan as well as do the ultrasounds whereas ultrasonologist can only do the ultrasounds. The basic used for PMH is that of an ultrasonologist and for CPH is of Radiologist hence the terms have been used interchangeably as Radiologist can be used at both the places. Wherever ultrasonologist is mentioned, it is requested that it may be amended to the term Radiologist. The qualification of the Radiologist is MD/DMRD/DNB in Radiology.

- 2. Informally, Radiologists were asked to join and three radiologist had also sent there Curriculum Vitaes too, but, due to the lack of timely affirmation from the Department, they joined elsewhere and later declined the offer.
- 3. The proposal envisages an advertisement through leading Newspapers and NDMC website portal as per the existing RRs in the Health Establishment.
